2020 GMRS VIRTUAL ROSE SHOW - ENTRY CATEGORIES AND INSTRUCTIONS

Horticulture Entries - Photography Requirements

- Photos may be taken on the bush or staged in vases (exhibitor choice); Keep the vase simple, we are judging the rose not the vase! You can even use water bottle etc.
- Two photos are required: 1) Full shot where the stem and foliage are visible and 2) clear shot of the bloom/blooms from above so that details can be evaluated
- Only 6 entries per class permitted; each entry within a class must be of a different cultivar

Horticulture Classes

Class 1: 1 bloom per stem, Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora

Class 2: 1 bloom per stem, Floribunda

Class 3: 1 bloom per stem, fully open Hybrid Tea, Grandiflora, or Floribunda

Class 4: 1 Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora Spray

Class 5: Single type bloom (5 - 8 petals), either single bloom or spray

Class 6: 1 Floribunda spray

Class 7: Polyantha single bloom or spray

Class 8: Climber, single bloom or spray

Class 9: Any shrub rose, single bloom or spray

Class 10: Any OGR cultivar

Class 11: Entry from any new member and/or novice (any cultivar from any class)

Class 12: 1 bloom per stem, Miniature

Class 13: 1 Miniature spray

Class 14: 1 bloom per stem, Miniflora

Class 15: 1 Miniflora Spray

Class 16: Single type bloom (5-8 petals), one bloom or spray, Miniature or Miniflora

Challenge Class Entries - Photography Requirements

- Two photos required, 1) Full shot of the display and 2) clear shot of the bloom/blooms from above so the quality of the blooms can be evaluated.
- One entry per class per member

Challenge Classes

Class 17: Rose in a Bowl; Any rose floating in a bowl of clear water, foliage permitted. See June GMRS Newsletter for details

Class 18: Rose in a Picture Frame; Any rose in a picture frame, foliage permitted. See article in June GMRS Newsletter for details

Class 19: Hi - Lo Challenge; Two roses, one large flowering type and one miniature or mini flora, exhibited in separate containers. Color and form of blooms should be similar.
